We will also be signing up for advancement on April 28.

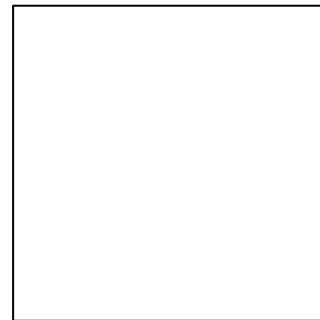
